

# High Quality Button Timers Available at Volare Products

After several months of difficulty finding the button timers formerly offered by FAI, I finally asked George Bredehoft if he would stock them. George came through promptly, and if you need a reliable button timer, go to [www.volareproducts.com/BUY/](http://www.volareproducts.com/BUY/) and you'll see that he now carries four different styles under his "accessories" listing. They still come with elastic cord for activating, which in my opinion is not a good idea because elastic gradually loses its tension over time and is not consistent. Just make yourself a spring from .009" wire, using the methods talked about in previous issues of this rag, and now found on the pensacola website [www.pensacolafreeflight.com](http://www.pensacolafreeflight.com). There's an article there on making your own, cheaply. I'm not sure that the ready-made winder by Kavork Fags is available any more.
