Sheet balsa tail group

Pins with heads removed, or pieces of copper wire cemented to trailing edge —

For precise adjustments to tail surfaces of balsa gliders, Tom Norwich, Sharpes, Fla., cements thin wire pieces cross grain at trailing edges. When bent, settings are retained.
